Specifically, abstracts should address topics that are of particular relevance to the practice of clinical oncologists and/or primary care.

Abstracts should be structured, with 300 words or less, highlighting background, methods, results and conclusions. Please submit your abstract as a Word Document; other formats will not be accepted.

Abstracts will be selected based on their quality, and invited for presentation as a poster or oral format.

More than one abstract may be submitted.
