Despite the incidence of rare tumors is very low by definition - not greater than 3 cases per 100000 inhabitants-, their overall impact in the population is by no means insignificant, given the considerable multitude of distinct types of rare neoplasms. Rare tumors pose a great clinical challenge for their diagnosis and management, and their rarity makes it difficult for patients to have access to health care facilities with adequate expertise, which may be insufficiently widespread on the territory.

The First Mediterranean Meeting on Rare Tumors will take place in Naples in 2011. The Meeting will host the official presentation of the Rare Tumors Excellence Center of Campania (Centro di Riferimento Tumori Rari della Regione Campania, CRTR), which has as its first objective the efficient functional integration of different areas of expertise, such as medical oncology, surgery and radiotherapy, along with anatomic and clinical pathology, radiology and epidemiology.

The Meeting will focus on the most updated scientific findings in the field of diagnosis and treatment of a broad range of rare tumors. As the Meeting will reunite specialists from various areas of Italy and, in particular, of Campania, it will offer the opportunity for coordination of clinical and scientific activities at a national and regional level. One of the key-messages of the Meeting will be that patients affected by rare tumors living in Campania do have the possibility to have access to centers of excellence in Campania itself, such as the new-born CRTR.
